Construction of infrastructure is ongoing in relation to development demands and improvements are typically either under construction or within the Town's warranty period awaiting final acceptance.

The Districts have received a certification of valuation from the Weld County Assessor that reports 2019 taxable assessed valuations for Erie Commons Metropolitan District No. 2 of \$28,941,070 and District No. 1 in the amount of \$210.00.
